

# TEA GARDENS SLIPWAY ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED

## Slipping Requirements

The vessel owner, by signing this document, utilises the slipway site at their own risk and that of their helpers and agrees to abide by and take full responsibility for adhering to the following Tea Gardens Slipway Requirements as sanctioned by the EPA and Marine Parks.

1. Work hours are 0700 to 1900 Monday to Saturday and 0800 to 1900 Sundays and Public Holidays, but restricted to daylight hours, ie sunrise to sunset.
2. Fuel removal or refuelling a vessel is not allowed at any time unless authorised by a slip operator.
3. All accidents and spillages must be immediately reported to a slip operator.
4. Workers must wear appropriate shoes at all times.
5. Avoid tripping hazards with electrical leads particularly in doorways. Outside GPO's should be used
6. A fire watch, including appropriate fire fighting equipment must be established when performing any hot work, particularly oxy-cutting and welding.
7. Vessels should be first scraped then washed. Vessel owners must clean the apron, sediment traps and trenches before painting mats are put in place
8. The slipway's on-site water blasting machine must only be used for cleaning antifouled hull areas and should be shut down immediately after use.
9. The wind direction and strength must be considered for all operations and work cannot be performed if there is the possibility for debris to fall or be blown into the waters of the Myall River.
10. Do not use the on-site garbage bin to dispose of marine growth material. This waste material must be disposed of responsibly off-site on the day hull scrapping is completed.
11. Do not dump waste material on grass and plant areas
12. Paint and other material must not be mixed inside the winch-house.
13. Paint tins and paint roller trays must at all times be kept in the plastic tubs provided to contain any accidental spillages.
14. The whole site must be cleaned at the end of each work day in case of rain. At the conclusion of your slipping, the site should be left as you found it, clean and tidy, including inside the winch-house.
15. The driveway gates must be kept closed when not in use and locked when leaving site. When open, the drop bolts must be secured in the concrete pads to avoid damaging the gates due to wind.
16. Vessel owners must ensure that all vehicles do not park across the footpath at any time.
17. Ladder covers must be in place and keys returned to the lockbox at end of each day.
18. Non-compliance with these requirements could attract penalties imposed by relevant authorities.
